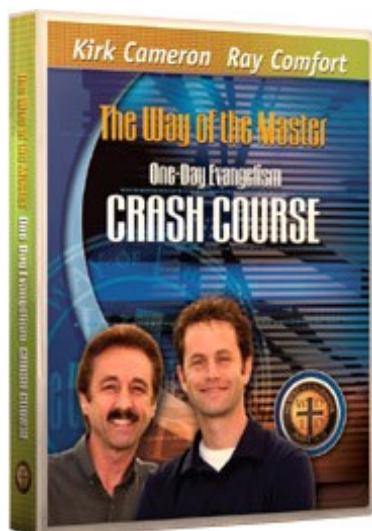
Questions & Objections:

Looking around the parking lot, I saw other vehicles had tracts like [America, America](#) on them as well. Praise God! He's raising up other laborers.

Our team of three was out again on Saturday. We're starting to see some warmer spring weather so the foot traffic and the number of people at Riverside Park is steadily increasing. We made a couple of passes along our usual stretch of 6th Street and a loop through the park where we gave out a good number of gospel tracts. We didn't pick up any one-2-ones but we still had an encouraging encounter at the park. A minivan slowed as it passed us and a young woman rolled down the window. She held up the [Ticket to Heaven](#) tract I'd given her. She said "This is wonderful. Good work guys!" God is good. Often times we face either opposition or indifference when we're laboring in the field, but he is faithful and puts encouragement like this across our paths to give us that second wind and enable us to keep going.

The encouragement came just in time too. As we made our final pass up 6th Street and headed for our cars, we found where someone had torn one of the tracts to shreds that Dave had given them. (We placed another one of the tracts in the corner of the picture above for contract.) It's amazing when a person will take the time or go to the effort to actually destroy the tracts. Sometimes this can be disheartening, but then I realize if nothing else

God will be glorified through it. I can only figure it's a sign of conviction. At the time of judgment they will not be able to say God was unfair ... that they never had a chance or never received the gospel message. It had been placed in their hands and they'd recognized what it was enough to stand there and tear it up. Pray that the Holy Spirit may take what this person had seen or read and use it to continue working on their heart.

Pray for the seed that was sown. Jesus, may you receive the honor that you're due!
