Weekly "Fishing" Report:

They were out on a scavenger hunt for a birthday party, but this wasn't your typical scavenger hunt. Carla Deems had put it together. During this part of their scavenger hunt, the girls were to go downtown Grants Pass and get at least three street interviews with [The Good Person Test](#) on video. This was great! Carla didn't actually plan it with this in mind, but with us going to be 45 minutes away to hold the training -- our usual fishing hole was still going to be manned and the gospel would still be shared there that afternoon. God is in control and He is good!



We had twelve people there for the training. At least half of those were newcomers. Monica had to be one of the highlights that night. At one point during the training she did a roleplay with Greg. He pretended to be a gentleman in a parking lot, while she used a tract as an icebreaker and then swung into [The Good Person Test](#). She demonstrated a classic witnessing encounter for the class. Ready for the punchline? Monica is 8 1/2 years old. It was too cool! Later on I asked if anyone could name all Ten Commandments. Her hand went up and she nailed that down too. Her parents told us they'd watched the Way of the Master DVDs, and while they thought Monica was just doing her homework she was listening to them too. Before they knew it she was passing out tracts and witnessing at her school. Praise God!



As Greg, Darrin, David and I talked afterwards, we each thought the training went well. Some of the new people plan to go out on the streets with us this coming Saturday to now put legs to the training. Pray that God will continue to encourage and equip these laborers.
