RULES

1. Attendance of the Friday morning meeting is mandatory. Please be sure you check in and get a name badge, so the others can get to know who you are. Name badges should not be worn during the actual seed sowing in the field -- just during the meeting.
2. Everyone attending is expected to participate. You won't be allowed to just be a "wall flower" at XE. You will be actively sharing your faith everywhere we go. We want this city to be changed after we've hit the streets as witnesses for Christ amongst a lost and dying world.
3. It will be hot summer weather. Dress accordingly, while still making sure your clothing is modest and appropriate Christian attire. We'll be doing a lot of walking, so be sure to wear "Comfort"-able shoes. Sunglasses can be useful as we travel from one fishing hole to another, but eye contact is important in a one-2-one or open air so take them off when witnessing. Lastly, avoid obvious "Jesus" message t-shirts.
4. Stay with your assigned team. Help to make sure everyone is accounted for as you arrive at or leave the various witnessing locations.
5. Restaurants will be selected where we will eat together as a group for dinner (Friday/Saturday) and breakfast (Saturday/Sunday). Lunches (Saturday/Sunday) can be picked up on your own (as a team) while out on the streets and in the field.
6. All attendees are expected to be soundly saved believers, so we would hope this isn't necessary to say, however ... **no drugs, alcohol or smoking** anything while attending XE.
7. For those staying at a hotel -- no girls in the guys' rooms, or guys in the girls' rooms. This is an evangelism event, not a singles retreat. (Naturally, this does not apply to married couples or families.)
8. Everyone who actively participates will receive their *eXtreme Evangelism* certificate at the end of the event.
9. Above all, you will be expected to do your best to be salt and light; maintaining a Christ-like demeanor while attending XE.
